Homework

Homework in Class 4 is topic based and is sent home at the start of each new topic. Tasks are divided into four categories, with several options in each. The children are expected to choose one task from each category as a weekly piece of homework over a four weekly cycle. The children are encouraged to share their homework with the rest of the class on Fridays. Year 6 will be set separate maths and English homework in preparation for SATs.

Spellings will be sent home on Monday to be tested on the following Monday. Please encourage your child to practise these at home and write/use them in context.

Pupils should continue learning and practising multiplication tables. These will be tested on a regular basis. Your child will know which multiplication table we are focussing in class. Please see me if you would like any additional maths homework.

The children should be reading at home on a daily basis - please ensure that they record this in their Reading Record book.

Please make sure that your child has the correct PE kit on PE days, and that homework is returned on the correct day.
