

Homework

Your child will bring home their book and reading record on a daily basis. This needs to be signed when you listen to him/her read and then discuss the story. You are very welcome to write any comments in the reading record as a member of staff will look at it on a daily basis. Reading is also monitored in school and we take part in a Guided Reading/Reciprocal Reading session twice a week.

A spelling list will be given on Friday to be tested the following Friday. Towards the end of Summer Term I may start to test a random variety of spellings that we have already learnt rather than send home new ones. The spellings will focus on the key High Frequency words and are in addition to the daily phonics that your child will be doing in class. Please help your child learn their spellings.

Friday will also be the day that the children will complete their Big Maths challenge test. Please continue to learn their 'Big Maths Learn It's' at home to help with this.

All children will be set a piece of homework on a Friday. This needs to be completed and returned by the following Wednesday. Please feel free to continue to access some of the websites that have previously been set as homework.

Please make sure that your child has the correct, fully named P.E. kit on P.E. days. We ask parents to send P.E. kits in each Monday and for your child to keep them in school all week. They can feel free to bring them home again each Friday but are usually prompted by us at the end of each half term.


