

## Homework

We will talk about images of children in artists' work and produce self-portraits using a range of drawing materials and techniques.

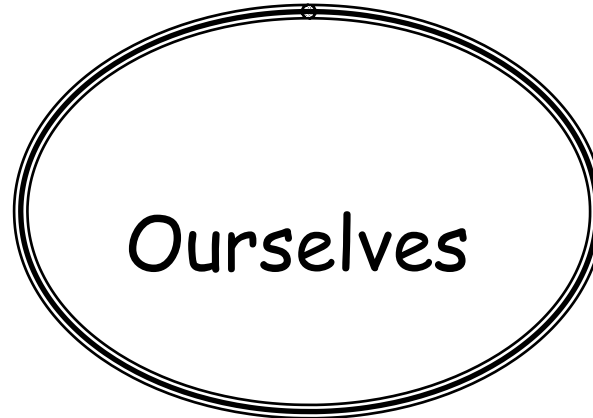
## ICT
