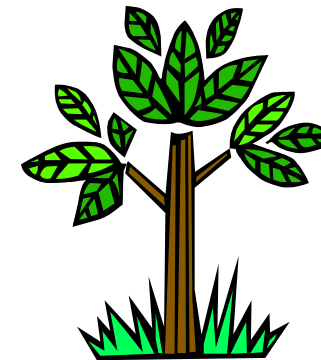

Class One

Literacy

Information Texts - We will be exploring how we can use books to find information and writing our own group information book about mini beasts and farm animals.

Instructions - We will be practising following written instructions and writing our own instructions.

Recounts - We will write a recount about our trip to Smithills farm.

Pattern and Rhyme - We will be getting outside and exploring poems based on spring/summer.

Art and Design

Using a selection of collage materials and discuss textures, colours and patterns, the children will create a textured picture based on the seaside.

ICT

Understanding Instructions in ICT around the home e.g. telephone. Controlling a Beebot - Creating, testing and modifying and storing a set of instructions to control a Beebot.

History

The Seaside - We will be looking at the seaside old and new. Looking at what children used to wear, play with and do whilst on holiday many years ago in comparison to now.



Maths

Count and order numbers 0-20 and recognise numerals. Join in with number songs and games. Spot shapes and patterns. Explore measures. Add and subtract with numbers 0-20. Recognise, name and describe features of 2D and 3D shapes and explore repeating patterns. Explore measures in the context of length, weight and time. Increase mathematical vocabulary.

Geography

Summerseat - We will be exploring the features/buildings of Summerseat.

Design Technology

Vehicles - investigating wheeled vehicles and then designing and making one linked to our 'On The Farm' topic. We will be focussing on tractors.

Music

Mr Powell will be with us each Friday teaching the children songs, rhymes and exploring different musical instruments.
